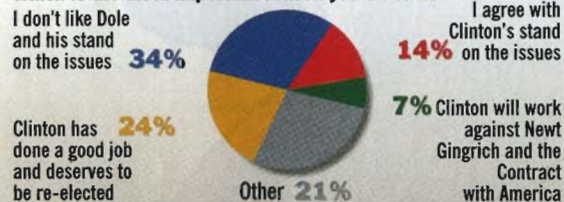
In the year leading up to the election, a large proportion of voters switched from opposing Bill Clinton's re-election to favoring it. Here are the groups where Clinton made the biggest gains, according to the TIME/CNN Election Monitor, a survey that returned periodically to the same registered voters.
